

Stormwater Pollution Prevention Begins With YOU!



Do not blow leaves and grass clippings into the streets or stormwater inlets

Use drip pans for leaky vehicles and equipment. Keep up with all scheduled maintenance



Apply all chemicals according to labels. Avoid spraying near inlets

Use dry clean up methods for oil and other spills. Dispose of cleaning materials accordingly



Keep the lid on all containers when not in use and are properly labeled

Properly store and maintain stockpiles in a safe, designated area



Keep the exterior of containers clean

Wash vehicles and equipment inside where water can be captured and treated



Pick up all trash and debris, including cigarette butts

Do not pour anything down a storm drain, even if it is labeled "Environmentally Friendly"



Remember, Only Rain Down The Storm Drain!
